Cost

The membership cost for the entire summer program is \$360.00 per child. There is a multiple sibling discount of 50% for each additional sibling.

Example:

Child 1 Cost:	\$360.00
Child 2 Cost:	\$180.00
Child 3 Cost:	\$180.00
 Total Cost:	 \$720.00

Registration

A Registration form must be completed for each participant at least 2 weeks before the start of the summer session. A \$50.00, per family, flat fee non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration.

Registration is for the entire program and there is no partial schedule registration.

All registration and payments must be done at Boys & Girls Clubs of the Western Reserve, Steve Wise Club, 889 Jonathan Ave, Akron, OH 44306. The Club is open for registration Monday-Friday 8:30 AM – 4:00 PM.

Scholarships

A limited number of scholarships are available for families in financial need. Financial need is based on the number of children being registered and household income. A Scholarship Request form must be submitted along with supporting documentation and may be submitted before registration forms. Please note that deposit fees are not covered by scholarships. Supporting documentation may include a Federal Tax Return, W-2 Statement, last 2 pay stubs or public assistance notifications.

Scholarship applications may be submitted before registering for the program.

Scholarship award announcements will be made by mail.

Full Scholarship

To apply for a full scholarship the family must demonstrate a financial need and have a household income level at or below the Federal Poverty line (see chart below).

Partial Scholarship

To apply for a partial scholarship the family must demonstrate a financial need.

Payment

Full payment for the summer program must be received 1 week before the start of the summer program.

Payments may be made weekly by either cash or money order. At this time we are not able to take debit/credit cards or personal checks. The minimum payment amount is \$50.00 or the balance due.

NOTE: Full payment must be made for registrations received after the start of the summer program (June 18, 2018). There is no pro-rated rate for registrations received after the start of the summer program.

All registration and payments must be done at Boys & Girls Clubs of the Western Reserve, Steve Wise Club, 889 Jonathan Ave, Akron, OH 44306.

If a registered sibling will not be able to attend the summer program and payments have been made for them, then the amount paid will be transferred to the balance of the other sibling(s). To qualify for this transfer a written notice of the sibling's non attendance must be submitted at least 2 weeks before the start of the summer program.

Refunds

No refunds will be made for "no-shows" or for members leaving the program early. All other requests for refunds must be made using the Refund Request form no later than two weeks after the beginning of the summer program.

Parent/Member Orientation

Parents and members that have not attended a previous Club Parent/Membership Orientation are required to attend one before the start of the summer program.

Orientations are held at the Club sites on various days beginning on June 4, 2017. Register for an orientation that will be held at the Club site the member will be attending. If a family will have members at more than one Club site they only need to attend one orientation.

You can schedule your orientation at the time of registration.
